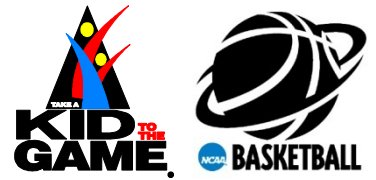


## 2009-10 "Game Day Schedule"

1:00—Volunteers Check in and receive assignments

1:15—Begin set-up of pre-game activities

### IDEAS:

- ✓ Sign-In booth for kids (can be used as kid's club mailer information)
- ✓ Face Painting Booth (supplies and example designs for display)
- ✓ Structured 3v3 or half-court basketball games (basketballs, colored pennies, whistle, scoreboard cards, referees)
- ✓ Free throw contest
- ✓ 3-point challenge
- ✓ Games of HORSE (substituting your school mascots name)
- ✓ Sports trivia questions booth (high scores announced during the game for prizes)
- ✓ Carnival games or organized activities
- ✓ School's sport teams booths with camp or scheduling information

2:00—Begin early registration

- ✓ Escort kids to pre-game activity area

2:00-3:45—Pre-game activities for TAKG attendees

3:45-4:00—TAKG seating

- ✓ Volunteers will begin to escort kids to designated area to see the players before they take the floor
- ✓ Volunteers will then escort kids to the TAKG section where they will watch the game.
- ✓ Two TAKG participants will be awarded the lucky seat winner (drawn from ticket stubs) each half, having the opportunity to get two free tickets to an upcoming game
- ✓ 1<sup>st</sup> half Alumni sponsored popcorn and drink break
- ✓ 1<sup>st</sup> half announce the TAKG attendance number and the lucky seat winner (who will also have the chance to "Meet the Team")
- ✓ Halftime photo opportunity with the mascot at half court (volunteers should line children up 5 minutes prior to half time)
- ✓ 2<sup>nd</sup> half announce the sports trivia winner
- ✓ 2<sup>nd</sup> half dress like your favorite student-athlete award, winner receives a free team jersey

Post-Game

- ✓ Student-athlete autograph signing with basketball camp informational booth
- ✓ TAKG information distributed for upcoming season (how to find out more about upcoming opportunities with TAKG at your school)
